

Good Evening. The St. Bernard Health Department will be holding its second H1N1 clinic that will be open to the public this Saturday November 7th from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm in the lower level of City hall. This clinic is again directed for those in tier 1 at highest risk. Tier 1 includes pregnant women, anyone 6 months to 24 years of age, people who care for or live with infants younger than 6 months of age, healthcare and emergency medical personnel, people ages 25 through 64 years of age who have chronic medical conditions or a weakened immune system.

We will have both the flu mist nasal vaccine available for ages 2 through 49 if healthy and non-pregnant and a limited supply of injections for ages 4 years and older.

We ask that you PLEASE enter the clinic from the side entrance closest to Fifth Third bank. We would like to thank those who attended the clinic last Saturday for their patience and assistance in helping make the clinic a success.
