

RESOLUTION NO. 3, 2010

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF ONE (1) INVOICE COVERED BY "THEN AND NOW" CERTIFICATIONS OF PURCHASE ORDERS EXCEEDING \$3,000, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, approval of the taxing authority is required for payment under a "then and now" certification when the related transaction amount is \$3,000 or more;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of St. Bernard, County of Hamilton, Ohio:

Section 1. That one (1) invoice for the Fire Department's "Paramedic training," being under a "then and now" certification greater than or equal to \$3,000, is approved for payment in the amount of \$7,150.00.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the necessary preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare or for the urgent benefit or protection of the inhabitants of the City of St. Bernard, and for the reason that payment is necessary to settle the legal obligations encumbered by the City which did benefit both the City and its citizens, and shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
