## **ORDINANCE NO. 15, 2016**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH NATIONAL AUTO FLEET GROUP FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) DUMP TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Service Director is hereby directed and authorized to enter into a contract with National Auto Fleet Group, in the amount of \$67,705.00, for the purchase of one (1) Galion 9 ft. stainless steel dump truck.

**Section 2.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is to enter into this contract as soon as possible for the purchase of the dump truck. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately by and upon its passage, and the approval of two-thirds of the members of said Council. However, this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date provided by law if approved by no more than a majority of the members of Council and in that event the emergency provisions herein are set at naught.
