

ORDINANCE NO. 28, 2016

FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF POLICE CHIEF AND FIRE CHIEF OF ST. BERNARD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of St. Bernard established a 4% increase for the Police Chief and Fire Chief; and


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the rate of compensation to be paid to the following full-time employees is fixed as follows, unless Federal or State law requires otherwise:

	<u>4% Increase</u>	<u>Annual Base Salary</u>
Police Chief	\$3,429.14	\$89,157.76
Fire Chief	\$3,387.14	\$88,065.77

Section 2: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is Council's desire that the compensation of the above mentioned personnel be established as soon as possible. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately by and upon its passage and the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council. However, this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date provided by law if approved by no more than the majority of the members of Council and in that event the emergency provisions herein are set at naught.


