Monitoring Schedule for Probe MP-8F

Dear Ms. Buchanan:

This letter is to inform you that, with the collection of 12 months of monitoring results below the compliance threshold of 5 percent (by volume) of combustible gas and in accordance with the Explosive Gas Monitoring Plan (EGMP) for the closed St. Bernard Landfill (Landfill), quarterly monitoring will be implemented at MP-8F effective January 1, 2017.

MP-8F had a reading above the compliance threshold in December 2015, just prior to the implementation of quarterly monitoring at the other seven probes. As a result, the monitoring frequency at MP-8F stayed at monthly. During 2016, MP-8F had 12 monthly readings below the compliance threshold. Therefore, per Section 2.1.1 of the EGMP, MP-8F will be reduced to quarterly monitoring frequency.

The next quarterly monitoring event for the compliance monitoring network at the Landfill, including MP-8F, is tentatively scheduled for the first full week in March 2017.
