Dear Ms. Lammers:

This letter is intended to meet the 7-day reporting requirements contained in OAC 3745-27-12 (E)(5)(g)(i). The 7-day reporting deadline is September 15<sup>th</sup>. The steps taken on behalf of the Village of St. Bernard at the closed St. Bernard Landfill to ensure the protection of human health and the environment include:

- Weekly contingency monitoring has been implemented at MP-9 in compliance with OAC 3745-27-12 (E)(5)(c) of the applicable version of the rule.
- The combustible gas alarms in the residences continue to provide detection of any potential accumulation of combustible gas in adjacent residences, with the one exception described below.

No additional monitors are proposed at this time. All the adjacent residences are equipped with combustible gas alarms, with the exception of 429 Bank Avenue where the owner requested that the alarm be removed. The existing permanent monitors are sufficiently closely spaced that additional monitors are not needed.
