ORDINANCE NO. 28, 2023

AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE AUDITOR TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL APPORPRIATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to provide additional appropriations to the following:

01 - 2-O-8C	City Hall Maintenance	\$98,000.00
01-5-A-14	CH Stationery and Printing	\$1,500.00
05-MP-6	Advertising	\$3,000.00
05-MP-9	Streets and Sewers	\$28,000.00
07-01	Capital Improvements	\$132.000.00

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is that the above funds are needed to be available for payment of expenses not provided for previously. Therefore, this Ordinance shall

take effect immediately by and upon its passage, and the approval of two-thirds of
the members of said Council. However, this Ordinance shall take effect on the
earliest date provided by law if approved by no more than the majority of members
of Council, and in that event, the emergency provisions herein are set at naught.
