ORDINANCE NO. 32, 2023

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN ROOFING AND METAL FOR ROOF REPLACEMENT AT VINE STREET PAVILION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the Village of St. Bernard finds it necessary and in the best interest of the Village to authorize the Service Director to enter into a contract with American Roofing and Metal for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary for the roof replacement at Vine Street Pavilion.

Section 2. The Service Director is hereby directed and authorized to enter into contract with American Roofing and Metal in the amount of \$131,540.00.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is to enter into this contract as soon as possible to complete the Vine Street Pavilion Roof Replacement project. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately by and upon its passage, and the approval of two- thirds of the members of said Council. However, this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date provided by law if approved by no more than a majority of the members of Council and in that event the emergency provisions herein are set at naught.
