AN APPLICATION FOR OHIO DEPARTMENT OF
NATURAL RESOURCES GRANT AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the State of Ohio NatureWorks grant program and

WHEREAS, the Village of St. Bernard desires financial assistance under the NatureWorks Grant Program,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of St. Bernard, County of Hamilton, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Village of St. Bernard approves filing this application for financial assistance.

Section 2. That the Service Director, Thomas Paul is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section 3. That the Village of St. Bernard does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the **NatureWorks Grant Program.**

Section 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the necessary preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare or for the urgent benefit or protection of the inhabitants of the Village of St. Bernard, and for the reason that payment is necessary to settle the legal obligations encumbered by the Village which did benefit both the Village and its citizens, and shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
