ORDINANCE NO 21, 2020

CREATING THE POSISTION OF FINANCE ASSISTANT AND FIXING THE RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR THIS POSITION STARTING AUGUST 1, 2020 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the full-time position of Finance Assistant be created to allow the employee to assist in both the Auditor and Tax Department:

<u>Section 2.</u> That the rate of compensation to be paid to the following full-time employee is fixed as follows:

Finance Assistant:	52 WEEKS
First Year	\$56,000.00
Second Year	\$57,120.00
Third Year	\$58,260.00

Section 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is Council's desire that the compensation of the above-mentioned personnel be established as soon as possible. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately by and upon its passage and the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council. However, this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date provided by law if approved by no more than the majority of the members of Council and in that event the emergency provisions herein are set at naught.
