

ORDINANCE NO. 23, 2018

FIXING THE COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS FOR BOTH THE POLICE AND FIRE CHIEF OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD AS OF JULY 26, 2018 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the base rate of compensation to be paid is fixed at \$88,065.77 for both the Police and Fire Chief. All future raises will be tied to the percentage increases that are awarded in the collective bargaining agreements for their most immediate subordinates in their respective departments.

Example: Police Lieutenant gets 3% increase then the Police Chief gets the same. If there is a 0% increase for the year then the Police Chief does not get an increase.

Fire Captain gets a 2% increase then the Fire Chief gets the same. If there is a 0% increase for the year then the Fire Chief does not get an increase.

Section 2. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for their immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is Council's desire that the compensation of the above-mentioned personnel be established as soon as possible. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately by and upon its passage and the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council. However, this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date provided by law if approved by no more than the majority of the members of Council and in that event the emergency provisions herein are set at naught.
