ORDINANCE NO. 26, 2017

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF ST. BERNARD, OHIO, REVISING THE TRAFFIC AND GENERAL OFFENSES CODES TO COMPLY WITH STATE LAW, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed, which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of St. Bernard, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, there have been numerous statutes passed since the last codification which should be reflected in the Traffic and General Offenses Codes in the Codified Ordinances; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the editing, arrangement and numbering of those ordinances and resolutions enacted by Council from 07/01/2017 to 10/01/2017, as listed in the Comparative Section Table, are hereby approved and adopted as printed in the October, 2017 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances so as to achieve uniformity of style and classification. A copy of such Replacement Pages is attached to this ordinance and incorporated as a part hereof.
