

ORDINANCE NO. 28, 2022


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MCCLUSKEY CHEVROLET FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2023 CHEVROLET TAHOES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. The Police Chief is hereby directed and authorized to enter into a contract with McCluskey Chevrolet, in the amount of \$92,978.00, for the purchase of TWO (2) 2023 Chevrolet Tahoes.


Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is to enter into this contract as soon as possible for the purchase of the Chevrolet Tahoes. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately by and upon its passage, and the approval of two-thirds of the members of said Council. However, this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date provided by law if approved by no more than a majority of the members of Council and in that event the emergency provisions herein are set at naught.


