

ORDINANCE NO. 40, 2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WARREN FIRE EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIRE DEPARTMENT TURNOUT GEAR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. BERNARD, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. The Director of Public Safety and Service is hereby directed and authorized to enter a contract with Warren Fire Equipment in the amount of \$55,365.95.00 for the purchase of Turnout Gear for the Fire Department and related components.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is to enter into this contract as soon as possible to improve the protection of life and property of the citizens with the new Turnout Gear for the Fire Department. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately by and upon its passage, and the approval of two- thirds of the members of said Council. However, this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date provided by law if approved by no more than a majority of the members of Council and in that event the emergency provisions herein are set at naught.


